- 400 800mcg Folic acid ↓ incidence of NTD
- 4000 mcg prevents 72% recurrence

- 95% occur as first occurrence
- Folic acid helps in both occurrence and recurrence



 It is important all women receive folic acid before or immediately after conception





- Most pregnancies unplanned & women unaware of pregnancy
